“RAGGING IS COGNIZABLE OFFENCE AND IS BANNED IN ANY FORM INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE CAMPUS”

Ingredients/forms of Ragging

- ➔ Abetment to ragging;
- ➔ Criminal conspiracy to rag;
- ➔ Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;
- ➔ Public nuisance created during ragging;
- ➔ Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- ➔ Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- ➔ Wrongful restraint;
- ➔ Use of criminal force
- ➔ Assault as well as sexual offences or
- ➔ Extortion;
- ➔ Criminal trespass;
- ➔ Offences against property;
- ➔ Criminal intimidation;
- ➔ Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned
- ➔ All other offences following from the definition of “Ragging”

Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion cast, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.

Punishments

1. Cancellation of admission
2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges;
3. Withholding/Withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
5. Withholding results
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international, tournament, youth festival etc.
7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 14 semesters.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent Debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
10. Fine ranging between Rs. 25,000/-to Rs. 1Lakh
- Rigorous imprisonment upto 3 years
11. Collective punishment When the persons Committing Or Abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resorts to collective punishment
